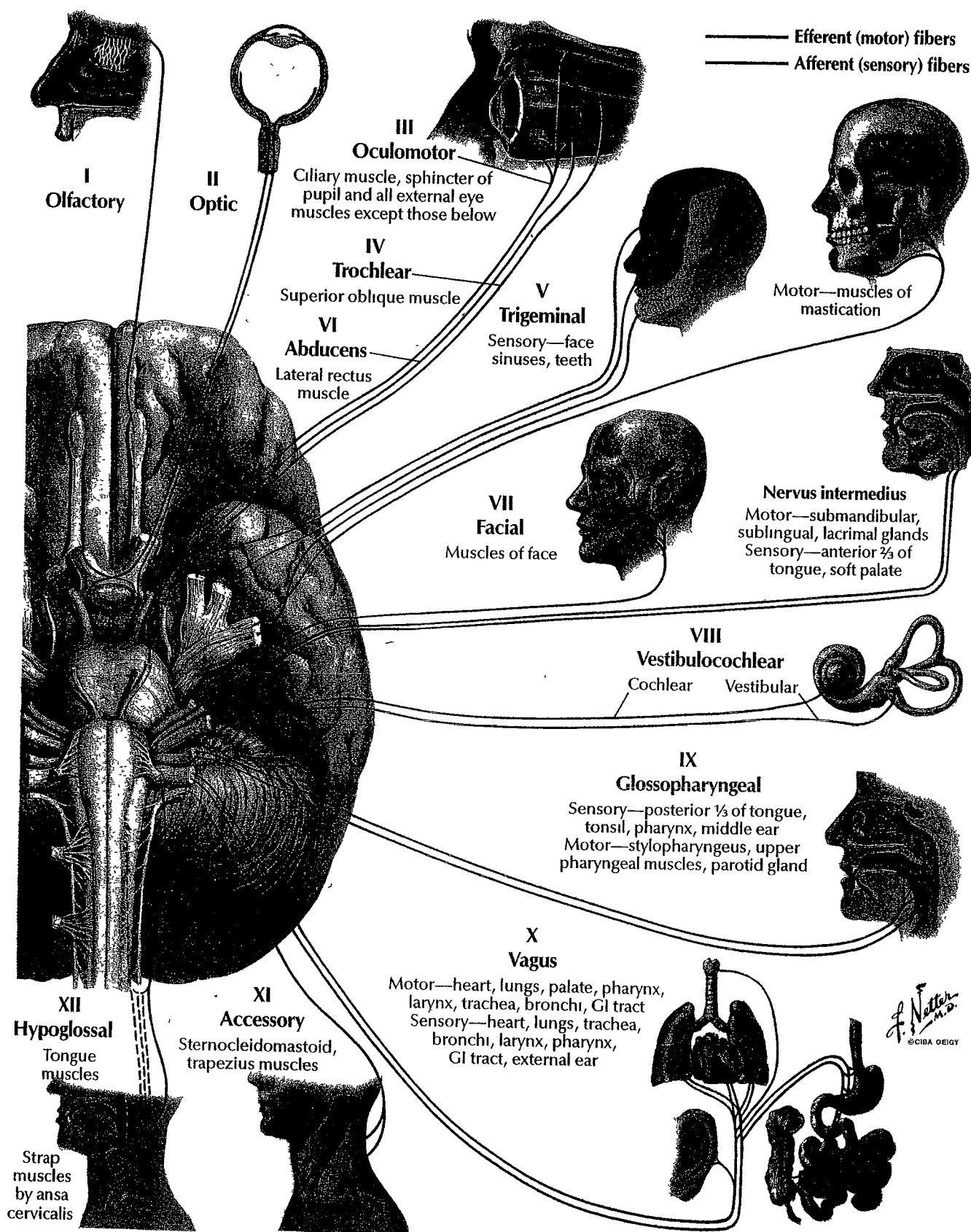
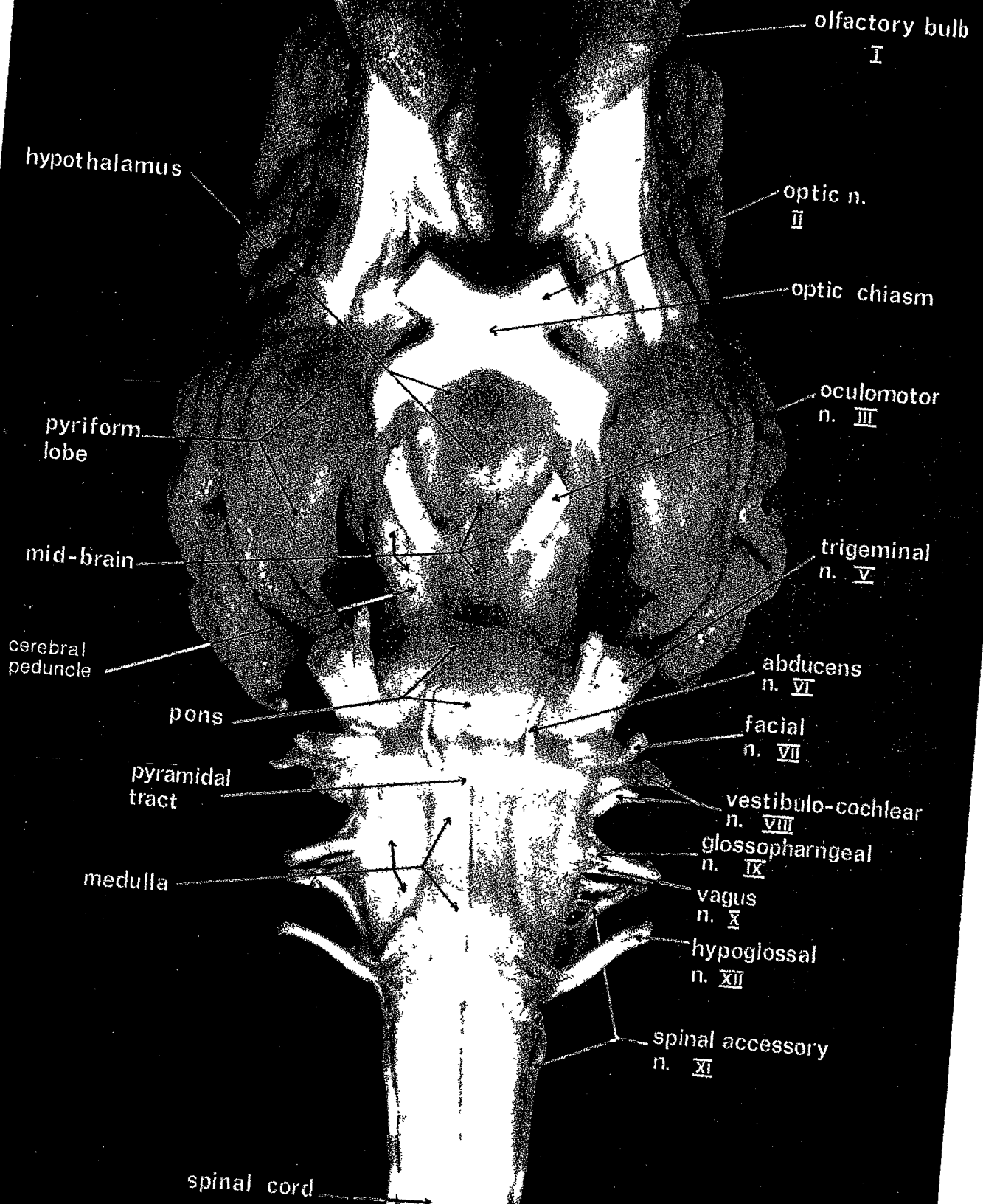
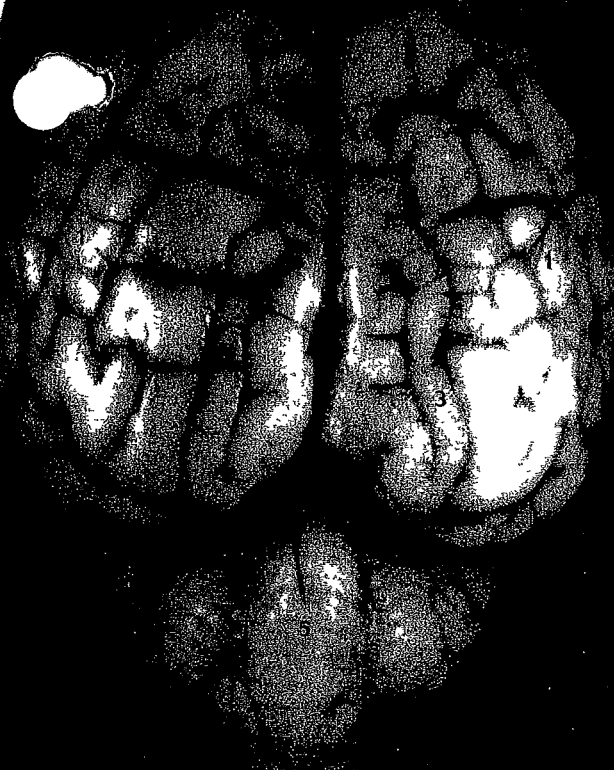


Cranial Nerves (Motor and Sensory Distribution): Schema

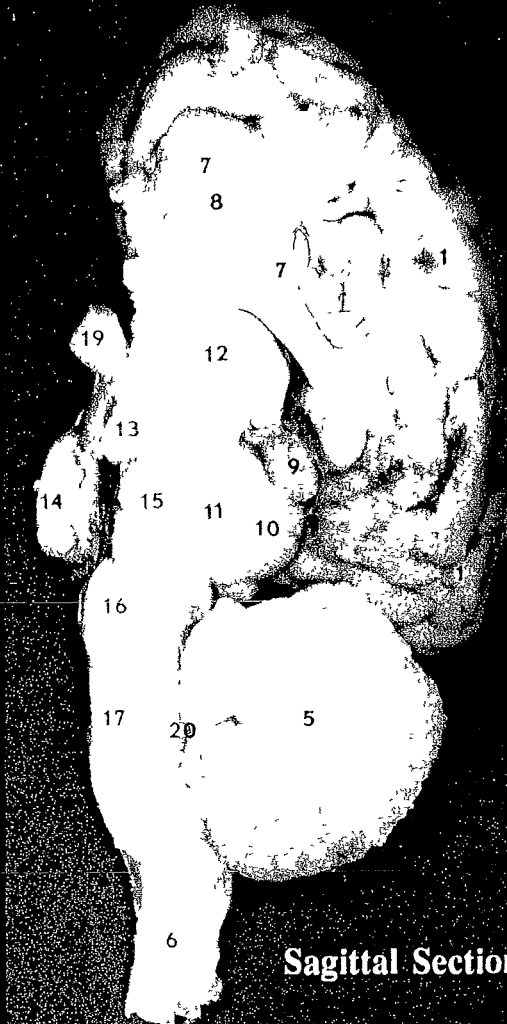
