1. Instructor Contact

- Online/Blended Courses: Your instructor will email you before classes begin with instructions to access course materials.
- In-Person Courses: You may or may not hear from your instructor before the first class. Check your course schedule for times and locations.

2. Moodle Access

Moodle is VCC's platform for online course materials (used in all course formats).

- Login: Use your VCC student ID and password (same as myVCC).
 - First-time login password format: VCCMMDDYY# (your birthday as MMDDYY).
- Help:
 - Watch Introduction to VCC Moodle.
 - Complete the Online Learner Success (OLS) Tutorial for a Moodle overview.
- 3. **Getting Oriented:** Explore the <u>Student Orientation and Resource (S.O.A.R.)</u> for help with online access, campus navigation, and study skills.
 - Enrolment key: welcome

4. Textbooks & Lab Manuals

- Wait for instructor guidance before buying textbooks.
- Academic Upgrading (ABE) Courses: Many textbooks may be available to download or borrow from the VCC Library.
- **UT Courses**: Textbooks are usually purchased through the VCC Bookstore.
